- 2. May Meeting Minutes Review & Approval (see email from R. Houck); Revise B. Gotsch name; motion to B. Gotsch to approve; seconded by B. Nechamen; motion passed.

3. Treasurer's Report

Sent by B. Nechamen on 5/12; attached to end of minutes

- Membership checks need to be deposited
- Nature Conservancy grant of \$15,000 came in. Giliday to be paid
- \$3,600 from exhibitors in bank; discuss how to handle
- Yearly budget changes; conference income is essentially zero; some revenue from workshops will be coming in
- No ASFPM conference in person fees (\$6,000); will need to be discussed by board.
- R. Houck motion to approve report; B. Zitani seconded; motion passed.

4. 2020 Annual Conference Update

- Conference committee met last week and recommended canceling our Sept. inperson conference.
- Conference organizer Helms-Briscoe looking into other options; reschedule for Spring 2021?
- Committee discussed alternatives for in -person conf: 1) Virtual conference; or 2) virtual workshops/webinars to offer some conf. or related materials. Full virtual conference was decided to be too extensive an undertaking to manage by September. Recommended focusing on 2). Workshops/webinars.
- Professional credit is an issue will be able to get more CFM credit by web training now than previously allowed.
- ASFPM virtual conference is June 9-11. Can get CFM credit; \$300 for members.

5. Annual All Membership Meeting

- Board discussed hosting a virtual membership meeting as our first FSMA virtual event; discussed adding a presentation – perhaps a web platform summary/update/pre-launch? 1 hour limit to meeting suggested.
- 6. Web Meeting Platform update (C. Flynn and S. Adams)
 - A beta version of the website is under committee review; the review will be forwarded to the website advisory committee; launch/changeover to be discussed.
 Designer to provide website admin training.
 - Sign-in required for forums; most of our website is accessible without sign-in; certain content is restricted to members, needing a log-in. Discussed allowing non-members to view content by registering on the web, or keep full access to members only. "Open access" would provide a greater email contact list beyond our membership. General view of the board was to keep certain content restricted to members.

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- Website contract ends June 1 but likely an extension will be needed due to CoVID impacts.
- Web platforms for virtual meetings. B. Nechamen and R. Lopez-Torrijos investigated GoTo Webinar, WebEx, Zoom. A proposal was discussed for the board approve a short-term contract 1-2 month to test a meeting platform. Costs \$15/month to \$50/mo for up to 100 per meeting. Easy access is a consideration. A motion was made by C. Flynn to allow the website committee to utilize the 2020 AV budget of \$1200 to set up a short-term with a web meeting platform; B. Zitani seconded; motion passed.
- The board discussed use of the extra \$9000 budget from grant for website development; how much extra be used? Suggested using for enhancement or outreach. Committee to look into areas of enhancement for use of extra budget and will make a recommendation to the board.
